

## SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

A limited number of full and partial Community Creative Center tuition scholarships are available for children and adults who have shown a strong interest in art and demonstrate financial need. All scholarships are dependent on the availability of funding and class availability.

### Eligibility:

#### 1. Full Scholarship:

- Children: who qualify for **free lunch** at public school, or children who don't attend public school but meet the same financial qualifications as those who receive **free lunch**
- Adults: whose children qualify for **free lunch** at public school, or adults who meet the same financial qualifications as those with children who receive **free lunch**

#### 2. Eligible for Partial Scholarship:

- Children: who qualify for **reduced price lunch** at public school, or children who don't attend public school but meet the same financial qualifications as those who receive **reduced price lunch**
- Adults: whose children qualify for **reduced price lunch** at public school, or adults who meet the same financial qualifications as those with children who receive **reduced price lunch**

### Frequency of Scholarships:

Students are eligible for at least one (1) scholarship per school semester; one (1) scholarship during spring break; one (1) scholarship during intercession(s); one (1) scholarship during summer session. Priority is given to students who haven't received a scholarship in the last six months.

### Deadline:

Application must be submitted at least 2 weeks prior to the start of the desired class. Students will be informed of the scholarship award at least one week prior to the start of a class session.

### To Apply:

Complete the attached **Community Creative Center Scholarship Application** and submit it with one of the following:

1. If your child attends public school: A signed letter on letterhead from the school stating the child's percentage of lunch program.
2. If you have no children in the public school district, a copy of your last tax return and/or letter of hardship from a qualified reference.
